On March 14th, the 10th annual Traditional and Green Skills event will be held at the Prairie Farm School. It is a cooperative venture between the Hay River Transition Initiative (HRTI) and the Prairie Farm Community Education Program. HRTI supports a more resilient, vibrant and sustainable community through principles such as reskilling, open space meetings, and relocalization.

Traditional and Green Skills is an exciting opportunity for young and old to learn from their neighbors and get more connected. More than 20 classes are available to choose from, all taught by local volunteers. As a matter of fact, the entire event is organized and coordinated by volunteers. The event has gained recognition, and we usually have close to 300 attendees!
